Food assistance programs, such as Meals on Wheels and food pantries, can help make healthy food more affordable for older adults, ensuring they get the vitamins, minerals and calories they need to stay healthy.

## Meals on Wheels

In Rhode Island, a single organization provides Meals on Wheels throughout the state. Meals are delivered each weekday and provide one-third of the participant's recommended daily dietary intake. The program also provides a daily well-being check and helps to lessen isolation. Other programs offered include cafe programs and pet food delivery.
